## **Definitions**

Off-the-rack: Wedding gowns and dresses found in stores and boutiques.

Runway: Gowns by designers, many walk the runway during Fashion Week.

Online: Many Brides-to-be are choosing to buy their gown or dress from stores online.

Rent: Many dresses and runway gowns are available for you to rent and return.

Customized by Designer: You buy a gown and have it altered and customized to fit and match you perfectly.

Couture: Designed and created 100% by scratch using materials, colors, and designs specifically tailored to and influenced by each specific bride<sup>i</sup>.

Pre-owned: Gowns sold by owners at steep discounts. May or may not have been worn<sup>ii</sup>.
